

## HOW TO GET TO THE CLUB

The Club meets at;-

The Elmwood Youth and Community Centre 53 Darlington Road, Stockton-on-Tees TS18 5EP

If you have a computer with access to the internet, by entering the above post-code into <a href="http://www.multimap.com">http://www.multimap.com</a> you will be provided with a detailed map of the district and route directions if required. For those who don't have access to the internet we hope that the following directions, plus attached map, will prove to be adequate.

- 1 From Sunderland, Newcastle etc.
  - . a Take the A19 South.
  - . b Leave the A19 at the Exit marked A1027 (Billingham, Norton).
  - . c This Exit takes you on to a large roundabout, go all the way round for the Norton Exit.
  - . d Continue along the A1027 (Ring Road), going straight over 3 more roundabouts, and straight ahead at 2 sets of lights (plus 2 Pelican Crossings) for about 3 miles.

- . e About 400 yards past the 3rd roundabout (Oxbridge Lane) there is a fork to the right. This fork, to Darlington Road, has to be watched out for as it is not very well signposted.
- . f About a further 400-500 yards down Darlington Road, you will find a right turn to Green's Lane. The Elmwood Community Centre is on the corner of Green's Lane and Darlington Road.

## 2 From Durham

- . a From Sedgefield take the A177 to Stockton. You enter Stockton at the Horse and Jockey roundabout (just past a Tesco Hypermarket). Drive across.
- . b At the second roundabout past the Horse and Jockey, turn right. This takes you on to the Ring Road (A1027). Continue along the Ring Road (past 2 sets of lights and 1 Pelican Crossing) to another roundabout.
- . c This is the Oxbridge Lane roundabout. Follow 1e 1f, above.
- 3 From York, Northallerton, Redcar etc.
  - . a Take the A19 North.
  - . b Just before you reach the A19 fly-over across the River Tees, the turn off for the A66 (Stockton, Darlington) is signposted.
  - . c Continue along the A66 until the A135 Exit (Stockton, Yarm) is indicated. This is a roundabout (under the A66).
  - . d Turn right on the roundabout, heading for Stockton.
  - . e After about 200-300 yards, there is a set of traffic lights by a new estate. Go straight ahead at THESE lights. At the NEXT set of lights, shortly after, turn Left.

f About 300 yards past these lights, the main road (Hartburn Lane) bears left on to Darlington Road.

g Continue as in 1f.

## 4 From Darlington

- . a Take the A66 towards Stockton.
- . b The most convenient exit from the A66 is the one which takes you to Eaglescliffe / Yarm

(South), or Redmarshall / Carlton (North). Taking this exit, then the 2nd exit on the associated mini roundabout takes you on to Darlington Road.

. c The Elmwood Community Centre is about 1/2 mile down Darlington Road on your left (at the junction with Green's Lane)
